There are the happy times of children's clubs with the Church and Manse garden overrun with up to a hundred children. There were the desperate times when the "Tin Tabernacle" ran out of money and faced closing. There have been happy times with countless marriages, baptisms and parties in the Manse garden. There has been a time when the handful of those who remained to worship in the "Tin Tabernacle" looked around at their diminishing numbers and despaired over the future.

The one constant in the highs and lows of the last hundred years has been God's faithfulness. That is God's steadfastness, firmness, fidelity to bless His children with many blessings. Also, God's steadfastness, firmness, fidelity to walk with His children to protect and care for them when life is hard, and the storms of life are threatening to overwhelm them.

It is fair to say that all that has sustained those who worshiped together over the years on that plot of land is God's faithfulness, that is God's steadfast, firm, unchanging decision to lavish His love on them.

So, on Sunday 4th of December at 16:30 we will be celebrating God's faithfulness and saying thank you. Why not come along and join us!

Following the article on Sergei Stepniak I was grateful to receive information regarding the circumstances in which he and his wife came to be short term residents in Limpsfield. May I begin with a puzzle? What is the connection between Stepniak, a tortoise, a Roman General, Limpsfield and Scotland Yard? The answer is The Fabian Society. This is a British socialist organisation whose purpose is to advance the principles of democratic socialism and it was founded in 1895 at The London School of Economics. One of the founder members was Edward Pease. The Society was named in honour of the Roman general Quintus Fabius Maximus Verrucosus. His military factic was to win conflict by wearing down the opposition as opposed to battle confrontation hence his nickname the Cunctator, meaning the Delayer. This chimes with the Fabian Society principle of non revolutionary change which is exemplified by their logo, a tortoise. In spite of his revolutionary history Stepniak joined the Fabian Society. In 1890 Stepniak founded the Society of Friends of Russian Freedom and Edward Pease became the Secretary. Pease lived in Limpsfield and it appears that he was the catalyst for The Stepniaks presence in the Limpsfield area. An interesting aside is that The Garnett family were also residents of Limpsfield and members of The Fabians. Stepniak assisted Constance Garnett in her translation of Russian works into English. Constance was the first person to translate the works of Tolstoy, Dostoevsky and Chekhov into English.

The Scotland Yard connection? Robert Fabian (Bob) was a well known and successful Scotland Yard detective.
