Harvest success for St John's Church This year instead of bringing harvest produce to church for our harvest festival celebrations, we invited donations to buy a gift, through the charity 'The Ripple Effect', for families in rural communities in far off lands who are finding times tough at the moment. A simple gift can be life-saving. For example, the gift of a chicken will provide eggs to eat, any surplus can be sold and bring in vital income and the droppings will enrich the soil and so help crops to thrive.

We chose four different gifts, and between us, from the £1,325 raised, we have now bought 35 chickens, 9 goats, 10 beehives and 21 packs of 'super-strong' seeds - resilient seed varieties that withstand drought and flooding.

At harvest time we thank God for all that he gives us, not only our plenteous food supply, and we rejoice that it has been an opportunity to share with others God's gift of life.
