Oxted Country Market is a weekly local community market held in the Woodhouse Centre, opposite the Leisure Centre in Oxted. It has been in existence for almost 50 years and is one of a network of 150 markets across England and Wales whose business ethos is HOME-MADE, HOME -GROWN, HAND-CRAFTED.

Local artisan producers support the Market and create beautiful displays of their work for sale. On the home baked food stall, there is a wide range of homemade cakes and other sweet delights, plus savoury foods, preserves and honey. Also available are seasonal home-grown fruit & vegetables. plants and local farm eggs. Other stalls include a variety of handmade crafts, from hand-turned wooden items, to jewellery, knitted toys, creative embroidered fabric items, quilled artwork and decorations, plus cards and seasonal flower arrangements.

The Market offers a catering service and creates bespoke celebration cakes to order. It runs a weekly food ordering service which offers main meals, desserts, cakes, freshly made sandwiches and other options. The menu changes frequently and is available on request. Orders can be collected each Friday from the Market.

The Market is currently open from 9.30 to 11.30 am on a Friday morning, but from Friday, 6th December, it will be open from 10.00 to 12 noon. The Market has tea, coffee and cake available and entry is free. Christmas is nearly here and there will be lots of gift ideas for all the family at the Market, so come along and see what is on offer. We would be delighted to welcome you.





Moor House School & College Speaking up for DLD

Students, staff and parents and carers at Moor House, a specialist School & College for children and young people with language disorders in Hurst Green, have been Speaking up for DLD on



DLD is a hidden but common disability that affects 2 children in every class of 30, causing difficulties understanding and using language for no known reason.

Since it opened in 1947, Moor House has led the way in teaching and therapy methods for children with speech and language disorders, including DLD, with students making outstanding progress due to the life-changing and research informed education and therapy on offer. Through the work of their Research and Training Institute, they continue to be at the forefront of global research and training, taking the benefits of their work out more widely through published research, training and resources for professionals.

Now in its eighth year, #DLDday, coordinated by RADLD (Raising Awareness of Developmental Language Disorder), is celebrated across the world. This year's theme was 'Speak up for DLD', and so the Moor House community came together to do just that. In a special Podcast, some of their amazing students spoke up for DLD, with insights from two DLD experts, Sue Marr and Dr Susan Ebbels, based at the Moor House Research and Training Institute. Other activities to speak up and raise awareness included:

- Some incredible student displays and artwork
- -Themed classroom activities and assemblies
- A special DLD parent workshop
- -Sharing DLD information with our local community at Hurst Green Station
- -Decorations around the school and a non-uniform day, with staff and students wearing the RADLD colours, purple and yellow

Moor House Research and Training Institute Director Dr Susan Ebbels says: "It's been wonderful to see and hear our young people at Moor House speak up for DLD, and their enthusiasm to raise awareness is really inspirational."
