## Don't Grieve Alone in Hurst Green

Grief is a topic that people often struggle to talk about. It is one of the hardest things we will ever have to go through, and everyone will have to experience it at some point in their lives. Everyone grieves in different ways, and in a way that is most suitable to them but having recently lost my father I wanted to highlight that in Hurst Green there are lots of people to talk to both professionally, and informally. I have found much comfort from talking to my friends, neighbours, local groups and via St John's Church.

If you are struggling, never be afraid to seek help. In Hurst Green we are lucky to have the Community Fridge on a Wednesday and the Community Hub on Thursdays where local residents can drop in and find friendly faces if they want to chat. There are also more professional groups available to attend such as the Oxted Churches Together Bereavement Group who meet on alternate Thursdays between 1-3pm. Anyone who has experienced the loss of a loved one, whether recently or longer ago, is welcome to drop in for a cup of tea and a chat with others in similar situations. Trained volunteers are on hand to give emotional and bereavement support. Grief is not limited to the death of a person. Losing a pet can often be as difficult, with owners experiencing loneliness and isolation. The Blue Cross offers support via a free and confidential helpline for anyone who has been affected by the loss of a pet. It's crucial to remember there is no timeline for grief and it's common for grief to come in waves, to ebb and flow over time. It's normal to continue to mourn the loss of a loved one in the weeks, months, years, and even decades after they pass. They were important, and their relationship with you was important.

For anyone experiencing grief, no matter how old or new I'm sending you love and prayers. There will be good days and bad days but please know that you are not alone.

The BioCube® is a patented habitat system designed to boost local biodiversity by creating layered, self-contained ecosystems. Each habitat within the BioCube® is carefully positioned to offer shelter and insulation from predators, extreme temperatures, and noise, helping to protect rare and endangered species native to their location (e.g hedgehogs, amphibians, bees, butterflies, and more).

Each unit contains native UK plants (complete with plant passports) and comes with an informational sign to educate and inspire residents to learn about local biodiversity and even consider installing their own wildlife-friendly habitats at home. While they require some initial care, they become low maintenance over time and are unsuitable locations for pests or rodents.

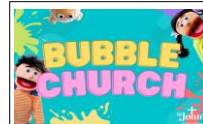

Phase 4 of Solar Together Surrey launched on 2 June. This group buying scheme helps residents save money on solar panels, battery storage and electric vehicle charge points by buying together.

You can register your interest until 8 August 2025. Offers will be sent out between 29 August and 19 September and you can then decide if you want to go ahead. Installations are planned to be completed by March 2026.

The scheme is run by Surrey County Council in partnership with iChoosr.

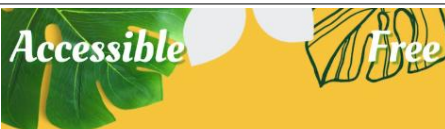
