Mind the acorns - it's a bumper year!

I'm sure you've noticed the excess of acorns this year. Everywhere I walk, they seem to be underfoot. At first, I thought that perhaps this is what this time of year is always like - that I've just forgotten, in the intervening year, that the onset of autumn is synonymous with acorns But then I discovered that this is a bumper year.

That oak trees, helped along by an underground network of fungi, plan these bumper years to ensure that there are far too many acorns for squirrels and mice and birds to eat, and more of the acorns will have a chance at planting and growing into the oak trees of the future.



If donations to the Hurst Green Community Fridge are anything to go by, this year has also been a bumper year for apples. We've had them coming out of our ears. Every one of our visitors has been sent home with a bagful of apples, some weeks. At home, I've been chopping apples to make into sauce and crumbles which I can pop in the freezer, and which I know my children will enjoy throughout the winter.

I watched a video online of a botanist, explaining how to test whether an acorn is good for planting, and how to grow little bonsai oak trees in pots. Once you know an acorn is plant-able, you have to keep it cold for a few months - either outside, in the soil, or in the fridge. This mimics the natural world, where a seed stays cold under frozen ground all through the winter before coming to life and sprouting in the springtime. The period of frostiness, bare leaves, the "dead" winter season is, in fact, necessary to produce new life

Christians bear witness to this fact about winter in our faith: Jesus died and remained in the tomb for three days before death gave way to his resurrection. When we go through trying times in life, like watchmen in the darkness, we trust that the dawn will come (Psalm 130). Winter does not last forever. Although the days become shorter and shorter, and the season can begin to feel endless, our tans well and truly faded and the summertime a distant memory... all the while the seeds are waiting, preparing to germinate. Important work is happening in the darkness, under the ground. We may not see it, but we trust that in the spring we will see green shoots, as we do each year.

Over the summer, the Community Fridge has been blessed with an abundance of produce. We are hugely grateful to everyone for their donations from their gardens and allotments, and to our regular supermarket donations. The coming months will see us having less. If you find yourself with anything spare and feel inclined to share it with the community, please do contact us or drop in to Aggies between 10.45-11.15 on a Wednesday. If you find yourself in need of anything - including some human contact and a warm drink through the winter! - then we'd love to welcome you from 11.15-12.15 each Wednesday.

true cauldron of musical delights.



Household Support Fund - Everyday Essentials E-voucher

As part of Household Support Fund 7 funding by the Department of Work and Pensions, Surrey County Council has launched the Everyday Essentials E-voucher.

This is open to eligible Surrey residents who may be struggling with the financial costs of everyday essentials. Eligible residents can receive up to £300 in the form of an e-voucher which can be redeemed at a supermarket of the applicant's choice.

Applications opened on 1 October and can be made until March 2026 or the funding runs out. The application portal opens each month and will close once that month's funding has been fully allocated and reopen again the following month.
